1. Call to Order; Roll Call

Chair Robinson

5. Program Updates

Staff

Lisa Jaret shared the new 2022-23 Annual Report postcards that were recently printed and gave some to TCAB members to take with them.

Clarissa Gines provided an update on the 2024-25 funding cycle, and announced that the guidelines and applications were released. She also shared information on the variety of application assistance that is available, including application workshops, drop-in conversation hours, and scheduling meetings with staff.

Lisa Jaret then shared that four TCAB members have been confirmed to serve on Tacoma Creates funding panels, and that staff are in the process of identifying community members to serve as panelists. She then shared that meetings with Councilmembers have been scheduled and staff is in the process of getting TCAB members confirmed to meet with them about the reauthorization process.

Lisa Jaret introduced guest presenter Bernie Rhoades, Assistant Director of Youth Learning at Greentrike, who provided insight on Greentrike's role in the coordination of the Beyond the Bell and Club B program. Chair Robinson facilitated questions and comments from TCAB members.

8. OACV Staff Reports

Clarissa Gines shared the open opportunity for a part-time Artist in Residence (AiR) with Public Works, and announced that the Washington State Department of Commerce just released their strategic plan.
