*******BACKGROUND



Completed Transformation efforts

- Body Worn Cameras fully implemented (all officers with citizen interaction are wearing cameras)
 - AXON Performance Software overlay pilot program
- "8 Can't Wait", "Bias Free Policing", Ban on Chokeholds fully bargained and implemented
- Civilian Chief of Staff position in TPD (negotiated)
- Translation Services updated to avoid relying on citizen translation, and to include ease of access and video.
- Numerous policy and procedure changes and training to begin implementation of 21CP and full implementation of 2020-2021 state legislation

- BWC policy updates (CPAC and TPD Operational)
 - · Dash camera policy update/inclusion
- Survey 123 demographic data collection tool
- Location tracking technology policy (GPS, AVL, Cellular, etc.)

SUES



Critical Achievements of Local 6 Agreement

- Removal of contract language allowing for purging of discipline from employee files
- Confirms ability and process for anonymity of citizen complaints
- Implements state law requirements for assignment of arbitrators to disciplinary grievances
- Changes to compensation formula and provision of market competitive wage increases to facilitate recruitment and retention
