- □ Offered training and assistance





PROPOSED REVISIONS




Gaps compared to Ecology's Model Ordinance

- ☐ Water wells shall be located on high ground that is not in the floodway.
- ☐ Construction or reconstruction of residential structures is prohibited within designated floodway.

Health


- Prevention of floods
