SUMMARY:

The CVS committee members will discuss how to build stronger relationships between CVS and the six commissions, boards, and committees (CBCs) that CVS oversees and may assign each Council Member specific CBC meetings to attend in order to begin building these relationships.

BACKGROUND:

CVS oversees six CBCs: the Commission on Immigrant and Refugee Affairs, the Human Services Commission, the Human Rights Commission, the Tacoma Area Commission on Disabilities, the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority, and the Community's Police Advisory Committee.

At the September 23, 2021 CVS meeting the committee discussed each CVS committee member visiting the six CBCs on a quarterly basis as a way to strengthen CVS' relationship with each of the six. Over the course of the remainder of 2021, Councilmembers Ushka, Blocker, and Hines visited each of the six CBCs. This discussion is meant to determine if CVS committee members want to continue these visits.

ISSUE:

CVS committee members have indicated an interest in strengthening the relationship between the CBCs and the committee.
