3 4	A RESOLUTION authorizing the one-time use of \$2,500, budgeted from the Council Contingency Fund, to fund litter pick-up tools for the annual volunteer-led Litter Free 253 event.

6	WHEREAS Litter Free 253 is a group of community volunteers who promote
7	the idea that everyone plays a role in keeping litter out of our streets, parks, and
8	neighborhoods through organized litter pick-up events, including an annual citywide
9	litter pick-up, and
10	WHEREAS this year, the South End, Eastside, and West End Neighborhood
11	Councils have teamed up to organize the City's third annual Litter Free 253 event
12	on April 16, 2022, and
13 14	WHEREAS teams or individuals who sign up through Litter Free 253 are
15	provided City-sponsored gloves, garbage bags, and safety vests through the City's
16	Adopt-a-Spot program, and last year, approximately 600 volunteers participated –
17	collecting about ten tons of litter, and
18	WHEREAS for this year's event, community organizers would like to
19 20	purchase litter grabbers to distribute to participants for use during the event, and
21	also to keep for future litter pick-ups, and
22	WHEREAS not having litter grabber tools is a barrier to picking up litter, and
23	since volunteers rarely have these tools, providing them will encourage more
24	people to join the event, will assist residents with mobility issues, and excite kids

about novel tools; this financial contribution will fund approximately 350 litter 2 grabbers, and

WHEREAS, as of March 15th, organizers have fundraised \$4,150 from the Community Council of Tacoma, Neighborhood Councils, local businesses, and through online contributions to fund additional grabbers and litter pick-up kits for each Neighborhood Council and to donate to the Tool Library, and

8 WHEREAS litter pick-up kits consist of one five-gallon bucket, a minimum of 9 ten litter grabbers, gloves, bags, safety vests, and a pass to dispose of the refuse at 10 no charge at the Tacoma Recovery and Transfer Center, and 11

WHEREAS, at the March 22, 2022, Study Session, Council Member Hines 12 13 shared a Council Consideration Request to authorize the one-time use of \$2,500 14 from the Council Contingency Fund to fund litter pick-up tools for the annual 15 volunteer-led Litter Free 253 event, and 16

WHEREAS City staff will negotiate and execute an agreement for services, 17 with terms and deliverables for the City's contribution, as well as a financial report 18 19 provided to the City which shows the source(s) of the funding prior to receiving the 20 \$2,500 contribution, and

21 WHEREAS RCW 35.34.250 and 35.34.260 authorize a withdrawal from the 22 Council Contingency Fund for any municipal expense, the necessity or extent of 23 which could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time of 24 25 adopting the budget, and

1	WHEREAS Ordinance No. 22569 requires an affirmative vote of not less
2	than six members of the Council in order to withdraw moneys from this fund; Now,
3	Therefore,
4	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:
5 6	Section 1. That one-time funding in the amount of \$2,500, budgeted from
7	the Council Contingency Fund, is hereby approved for the purpose of funding litter
8	pick-up tools for the annual volunteer-led Litter Free 253 event.
9	Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to
10	confirm deliverables with Litter Free 253 for the purposes hereinabove enumerated,
11	and document as appropriate.
