1 A RESOLUTION relating to collective bargaining; authorizing the execution of a Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and the 2 International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Human Resources Unit, to provide for a general wage increase retroactive to 3 January 1, 2022. 4 WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective 5 bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and 6 7 the administration, and 8 WHEREAS Resolution No. 40739, adopted January 26, 2021, authorized the 9 execution of the two-year Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") between the 10 City of Tacoma and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, 11 Human Resources Unit, ("Union"), on behalf of the employees represented by said 12 Union, and 13 14 WHEREAS the City and Union have negotiated a Letter of Agreement 15 ("LOA") to the CBA which provides for a 2.25 percent general wage increase 16 retroactive to January 1, 2022, for all classifications in the Union, which shall take 17 into account the 1 percent increase already provided to bargaining unit members on 18 19 January 1, 2022, and which shall cancel the 1 percent wage increase scheduled to 20 be effective July 1, 2022, and 21 WHEREAS it appears in the best interest of the City that the LOA negotiated 22 by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore, 23 24 25 26 -1-Res22-0446.doc-CAC/ak
