1 A RESOLUTION relating to collective bargaining; authorizing the execution of a Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and the City of 2 Tacoma, Washington, City and Pierce County Employees Local Number 120 of the Washington State Council of County and City Employees, AFSCME, 3 AFL-CIO, to provide for a general wage increase retroactive to January 1, 2022. 4 5 WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective 6 bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and 7 the administration, and 8 WHEREAS Resolution No. 40717, adopted December 15, 2020, authorized 9 10 the execution of the two-year Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") between the 11 City of Tacoma and the City of Tacoma, Washington, City and Pierce County 12 Employees Local Number 120 of the Washington State Council of County and City 13 Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, ("Union"), on behalf of the employees represented 14 by said Union, and 15 16 WHEREAS the City and Union have negotiated a Letter of Agreement 17 ("LOA") to the CBA which provides for a 2.25 percent general wage increase 18 retroactive to January 1, 2022, for all classifications in the Union, which shall take 19 into account the 1 percent wage increase already provided to bargaining unit 20 members on January 1, 2022, and which shall cancel a 1 percent wage increase 21 scheduled to be effective July 1, 2022, and 22 23 WHEREAS it appears in the best interest of the City that the LOA negotiated 24 by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore, 25 26
