13 14	revenue fund, and this proposed Ordinance would help the City comply with the		
15	requirements of GASB #84 for financial reporting, and		
16	WHEREAS, the Tacoma Police Department currently reports cash deposits		
17	being held in trust until various court cases are adjudicated within a special revenue		
18 19	fund, and a new fiduciary fund is needed for these deposits in order to be in		
20	compliance with GASB #84, and		
21	WHEREAS it is the intent of the City to establish a new and separate fund,		
22	named the "Custodial Forfeitures Fund," for the purpose of segregating cash		
23	deposits that are being held in trust for others; Now, Therefore,
