




2021 Enhancements for Assistance

• Eligibility definition changed from Federal poverty guidelines to Health & Human Services (HHS) Fair Market Rent Area median.

Expansion of Water Grants & Loans

Program Details

- Grant or loan to **replace aged or leaking water line** associated with advanced meter deployment
- **\$5,000** grant for income-eligible and/or \$5,000 loan with zero interest for 84 months

Program Status May 2021 through May 2022

- 1 customer has received a grant of \$5,000
- · What can we do to expand the program and help more customers?

Program Expanded June 20222

- Eliminate 45-day window and AMI-enabled program eligibility
- Establish a tiered funding priority
- · Immediate results: 1 grant and 2 loans in progress





Energy Audit

- Tenants at 80% HHS Median or less
- · Build relationship with landlord and tenant
- · Comprehensive proposal prioritizing energy efficiency upgrades
- Energy efficiency kits for tenants
- Hands-on tenant education

Insulation

- 100% grant
- Conservation-related repairs funded with avoided tax on BPA incentive funding Heating & Windows
- Option 1: 100% grant (if owner signs affordability covenant)
- Option 2: 30/70% grant/interest free loan "split" (if no affordability covenant)



Community Partnerships

Financial Education/Coaching

- Additional, **one-time credit up to \$160** for eligible households who complete financial education/coaching through an approved community partner
- In conjunction with Goodwill and Sound Outreach
