**SUMMARY:**

Appointing and reappointing the following individuals to the Transportation Commission:

- Appointing Ruben Casas to the “District No. 2” position to fill an unexpired term to expire August 31, 2024.
- Appointing Austin Goble to the “District No. 3” position to serve a three-year term, effective September 1, 2022, to expire August 31, 2025.
- Reappointing Richard Gardner to the “At-Large No. 4” position to serve a three-year term, effective September 1, 2022, to expire August 31, 2025.
