I ask for your support for a \$5,000 Council Contingency Fund expenditure to support the Tacoma Urban League Empowerment Awards.

LEGISLATIVE INTENT:

Council Contingency Fund Request: Born out of the civil rights movement, the Tacoma Urban League has always been there for African Americans and other marginalized community members in the South Puget Sound. For more than 50 years, the Tacoma Urban League has provided services, training, and advocacy to build social and economic equality among Black people and other people historically marginalized in South Puget Sound.

The Empowerment Awards are an opportunity to recognize programs and partners that are addressing the needs of the Tacoma community. The Hope level sponsorship supported by this request will allow Tacoma Urban League to support its programs year round. These programs help address the particular needs of our Black and marginalized communities and support the City in our strategic goals.

FUNDING REQUESTED: \$ 5,000

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT/ (CUSTOMER RESEARCH):

The Tacoma Urban League works closely with Black and marginalized communities across Tacoma, including partnerships through the NAACP, and the Pierce County Black Collective to understand and address the needs of their communities. The programs that this funding will support address the needs identified by members and communities to remove barriers to their success.

2025 STRATEGIC PRIORITIES: Equity and Accessibility:

The Tacoma Urban League focuses particularly on Black communities, and other marginalized communities, to address their unique concerns and challenges. By addressing challenges and removing barriers to success, the Tacoma Urban League is playing a role in dismantling and rebuilding systems to ensure equity for all Tacomans.

Livability: Equity Index Score: Moderate Opportunity

Increase positive public perception of safety and overall quality of life.

Civic Engagement: Equity Index Score: Moderate Opportunity

Increase the number of residents who participate civically through volunteering and voting.

The Tacoma Urban League provides volunteer and civic engagement opportunities to work with organizations and government across Tacoma to address the needs of a thriving community. Through volunteer effort and programming, the Tacoma Urban League helps the Tacoma community meet livability goals as set out in Tacoma 2025.
