Step 1:

Add Capacity and DADU Resources at PDS

□ Preapproved plans

Consulting services for Architectural Design, Engineering, and Energy Code Analysis

☐ Site planning assistance and utility coordination

New staff capacity in PDS to fit pre-approved plans onto specific sites, facilitate connections with power, water, and sewer service

□ Reimbursement funding for permit fees

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···· Proposed First Step (Continued)

Step 1:

Add Capacity and DADU Resources in PDS

□ Preapproved plans

\$250,000 would procure design, engineering, energy modeling services

- □ New Position for Site Planning Assistance & Utility coordination \$300,000 for 1.0 FTE Engineer (2023-24 Biennium)
- □ Reimbursement funding for ADU permits (e.g., ~60-80 +/- permits valued at \$250,000)
