### **SUMMARY AND PURPOSE:**

Tacoma Water is requesting approval of proposed updates to the Water Rate and Financial Policy to highlight long-term financial planning, gradualism, equity, affordability and climate change as areas of focus.

### **BACKGROUND:**

### This Department's Recommendation is Based On:

The Water Rate and Financial Policy gives direction to planning decisions and helps ensure that Tacoma Water provides an adequate supply of safe, clean water to all customers efficiently, reliably, and at the lowest possible cost consistent with prudent utility management. This policy was last updated in November 2018.
