## **Briefing Items**

1. <u>22-0925</u> Board of Building Appeals Interviews [Doris Sorum, City Clerk]

At approximately 4:36 p.m., Doris Sorum, City Clerk, informed the Committee they would be interviewing two applicants for the Board of Building Appeals, and one additional interview has been scheduled for the September 14, 2022, meeting for Ben Ferguson, who is out of the country. She concluded by stating there are two positions available, including one Architect position, to fill an unexpired term, and one Mechanical/Plumbing Contractor position, to serve a five-year term.

The Committee interviewed James Dugan and Konnie Wells.

The Infrastructure, Planning, and Sustainability (IPS) Committee recessed at 4:57 p.m.

22-0926 Pacific Avenue Corridor Study
 [Wesley Rhodes, Senior Planning and Development Services]

At approximately 5:10 p.m., Wesley Rhodes, Senior Planner, Planning and Development Services, presented the Pacific Avenue Subarea Plan and Environmental Impact Statement (corridor study), including an agenda, current work, the environmental review, the purpose of the study, the geography of the study area, major project elements, community engagement, the Action Mapping Project, the timeline and milestones, and next steps.

Discussion ensued regarding how the study fits in with the Home in Tacoma (HIT) Project, subarea plans versus corridor studies, connection with other projects and entities, traffic issues and impacts of development, addressing Americans with Disabilities Act concerns in public transit, and community engagement and public feedback.
