Briefing Items

4. 22-0931 Youth and Young Adult Violence Assessment Update
[Vicky McLaurin, Interim Assistant Director, Neighborhood and Community Services]

At approximately 4:33 p.m., Vicky McLaurin, Interim Assistant Director, Neighborhood and Community Services (NCS), provided opening remarks and presented the youth and young adult violence assessment update, including project background and goals of the assessment. Ingrid Friberg, Epidemiologist, Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department (TPCHD), presented key findings, quantitative data, and quantitative findings. Arianne Sandel, Program Analyst, TPCHD, outlined the qualitative process, and themes identified by community members and representatives of community organizations related to higher and lower risk of violence. Friberg and McLaurin concluded by reviewing the recommendations and the next step to release a request for proposal to address the gaps identified in the assessment.

Discussion ensued regarding next steps, data collection and gaps in analysis, non-profits doing work around sexual violence, the partnership with Tacoma Public Schools, how the program has developed during the COVID-19 pandemic, and work being done by other agencies.

5. <u>22-0932</u> Language Justice Resolution and Language Access Plan [Maria Teresa Gamez, Language Access Coordinator, Media and Communications Office]

At approximately 5:06 p.m., Maria Teresa Gamez, Language Access Coordinator, Media and Communications Office, introduced Renee Meschi, Equity Action Collective Project Manager, TPCHD. Together, they presented the language justice shared resolution and Language Access Plan, including an overview, noting proposal and purpose; background; issues; the health, equity, and sustainability analysis; outreach and next steps; and recommendations.

Discussion ensued regarding next steps and working with other agencies.

MOTION: Council Member Daniels moved to forward the language justice resolution and Language Access Plan to the full City Council for consideration.
