THIRD AMENDMENT TO

AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF JAIL SERVICES BETWEEN THE CITY OF TACOMA AND PIERCE COUNTY

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT ("Amendment") to the jail services agreement between Pierce County (County) and the City of Tacoma (City) effective July 1, 2015 (the "Agreement") is entered into and effective under the new adopted rates on the first day January, 2023 (Effective Date) for the purposes set forth herein.

RECITALS

WHEREAS the County has incurred a significant increase in staffing vacancies due to retirements and resignations of corrections deputies;

WHEREAS the impact of the ongoing pandemic and staffing vacancies upon the inmate populations has resulted in new booking policies implemented by the Pierce County Corrections Bureau, in particular individuals arrested for misdemeanor offenses;

WHEREAS the aforementioned challenges continue to impact Pierce County Jail operations;

WHEREAS the County and the City of Tacoma desire and agree to extend the Agreement for a period of a maximum of six (6) months upon the same terms and conditions while the City secures a secondary contract with another housing facility for individuals arrested for misdemeanor offenses:

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration for the mutual benefits as set forth herein and the Agreement, the County and the City enter into this third Amendment to the Agreement, as follows:

<u>Section 1. Amendment of Section 12</u>. Section 12 of the Agreement is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The term of this Agreement shall be eight (8) years beginning July 1, 2015, and ending July 1, 2023.

<u>Section 2. Remaining Terms and Conditions</u>. All other terms and conditions of this Agreement shall be and remain in full force and effect.
