7	WHEREAS the Links to Opportunity Streetscape Project ("LTO Project") was	
8	initiated in 2016 to actively engage the community in designing streetscape	
9 10	improvements along Sound Transit's Hilltop Tacoma Link Extension route which	
11	runs along Martin Luther King Jr. Way between Division Avenue and South 19th	
12	Street, and	
13	WHEREAS this work includes ADA-compliant sidewalks, bicycle facilities,	
14	illumination, streetscape amenities, decorative and colored concrete sections, local	
15	art, landscaping, and street trees, and	
16 17	WHEREAS the LTO Project will affect pedestrian access and parking during	
18	construction, significantly impacting residents and business owners in the vicinity,

20	WHEREAS, at the December 13, 2022, Study Session, Council	
21	Member Daniels shared a Council Consideration Request to authorize the one-time	
22	use of \$10,000 from the Council Contingency Fund for the purpose of supporting	
23	the LTO Project, and

WHEREAS these actions demonstrate the community-based, inclusive and 1 equitable approach to education and engagement that was implemented during the 2 design phase of the LTO Project, and 3 WHEREAS the \$10,000 funding will contribute toward the total cost of 4 \$50,000, which is co-sponsored by the Public Works Department, in the amount of 5 6 \$30,000, and the Community and Economic Development Department, in the 7 amount of \$10,000, and 8 WHEREAS the LTO Project office will be located in the heart of the Hilltop 9 community, and the intent is to have a presence and location where residents and 10 business owners can review the scope and schedule of the project, ask questions, 11 12 log complaints, give suggestions, and find out more information regarding the 13 project, and 14 WHEREAS the LTO Project office will be staffed internally using existing City 15 staff, and 16 WHEREAS RCW 35.34.250 and 35.34.260 authorize a withdrawal from the 17 18 Council Contingency fund for any municipal expense, the necessity or extent of 19 which could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time of 20 adopting the budget, and 21 WHEREAS Ordinance No. 22569 requires an affirmative vote of not less 22 than six members of the Council in order to withdraw moneys from this fund; Now, 23 24 Therefore, 25 26 -2-
