2. <u>22-1259</u> Office of Health and Safety Briefing

[Laurie Hardie, Director, Office of Health and Safety]

At approximately 10:14 a.m., Laurie Hardie, Director, Office of Health and Safety, presented a briefing on the Office of Health and Safety, including an overview; Tacoma Safety's mission; the Tacoma Safety team, noting leadership, Safety Officers, and support staff; safety; Supervisor Training in Accountability and Recognition Techniques training, and the Safety Culture Excellence Workshop training; other safety trainings; safety services; racial equity and action plan goals; looking back on 2021 and 2022, noting reduced recordable injury rates and improving safety culture, corrective actions, and leadership engagement through key performance indicators; additional accomplishments in 2022; the Tacoma Safety program's top three goals for 2022, noting year-to-date progress; and current critical issues.

Discussion ensued regarding how safety helps with insurance rates, how often trainings are going to be conducted, whether police and other represented employees participate in the training, what the City is doing to protect employees, workers compensation claims, and aligning the City's goals regarding safety.
