RESOLUTION NO. 41163

BY REQUEST OF MAYOR WOODARDS AND COUNCIL MEMBERS BLOCKER AND DANIELS

A RESOLUTION authorizing the one-time use of funds in the amount of \$5,000, budgeted from the Council Contingency Fund, to sponsor the Mayor's Youth Commission of Tacoma 2023 Youth Summit.

WHEREAS the Mayor's Youth Commission of Tacoma ("Commission") was formally established by Resolution No. 40502 in December of 2019, after a year of outreach and development with young people on what they would want to see in a youth-focused commission, and

WHEREAS since then, the Commission has engaged with students and organizations across the City to address such topics as youth mental health, climate change, public safety in schools, and leadership development, and

WHEREAS the Commission has worked closely with contracted partners through the Foundation for Tacoma Students ("Foundation"), which has provided general support, facilitation, and education for the Commission, and

WHEREAS since the Foundation's inaugural "Charting our Future" conference in 2021, the Commission has hosted a panel or learning track specifically for young people to engage with, and

WHEREAS this year, following participation in the "Charting our Future" conference on May 4th, the Commission will host a half-day youth summit ("Summit") on May 5th with multiple learning paths for young people, and

WHEREAS the theme for the Summit is "Joy & Action!", and the Commission will bring 5-8 students from each of the Tacoma Public Schools together to share

leadership opportunities, educate, and inspire one another through interactive sessions, and

WHEREAS four learning sessions are designed and facilitated by the four committees of the Commission, and the sessions will focus on themes of social justice, health and safety, education, arts and culture, and environmental justice and climate, and

WHEREAS this funding will assist the students with securing an additional room at the convention center for their sessions and activities during the Summit, and will also support the cost of food and materials, including photography, development of a news magazine from the artwork and photos taken of performances and participants at the Summit, and recruitment materials for the Commission, to be shared with participants and schools, and

WHEREAS, at the March 14, 2023, Study Session, Mayor Woodards shared a Council Consideration Request to authorize the one-time use of \$5,000 from the Council Contingency Fund to sponsor the Mayor's Youth Commission of Tacoma 2023 Youth Summit, and

WHEREAS City staff will negotiate and execute an agreement for services, with terms and deliverables for the City's contribution, and

WHEREAS RCW 35.34.250 and 35.34.260 authorize a withdrawal from the Council Contingency fund for any municipal expense, the necessity or extent of which could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time of adopting the budget, and

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 22569 requires an affirmative vote of not less than six members of the Council in order to withdraw moneys from this fund; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That one-time funding in the amount of \$5,000, budgeted from the Council Contingency Fund, is hereby approved for the purpose of sponsoring the Mayor's Youth Commission of Tacoma's 2023 Youth Summit.

Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to confirm deliverables with the Foundation for Tacoma Students for the purposes hereinabove enumerated, and document as appropriate.
