

RESOLUTION NO. 41194

BY REQUEST OF DEPUTY MAYOR WALKER AND COUNCIL MEMBERS BUSHNELL, HINES, AND RUMBAUGH

A RESOLUTION relating to the Emergency Medical Services ballot proposition; appointing individuals to committees to prepare statements "For" and "Against" Proposition No. 1, concerning restoration of the City's emergency medical services property tax levy, which will appear in the voters' pamphlet for the August 1, 2023, Primary Election.

WHEREAS, on April 18, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution

No. 41180, transmitting a ballot measure concerning restoration of the City's emergency medical services property tax levy, to the Pierce County Auditor to be placed on the ballot for the Primary Election on Tuesday, August 1, 2023, and

WHEREAS per the Revised Code of Washington 29A.32.280, for each measure from a unit of local government that is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voters' approval of the measure, and shall formally appoint committees to prepare arguments advocating voters' rejection of the measure, and

WHEREAS the City reached out to the community to look for those interested in serving on the committees by notifying those on the mailing lists from the Tacoma Fire Department, those on the agenda notification lists, Neighborhood Council contacts, as well as anyone else who expressed interest in the past about the topic, and posted the request on the City's notices page, and

WHEREAS the Government Performance and Finance Committee reviewed letters of interest at their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday,



May 2, 2023, and provided recommendations for the appointment of individuals for the "For" and "Against" Committees for Proposition No. 1; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the nominees for the "For" and "Against" Committees, as listed in Exhibit "A," are hereby confirmed and the persons designated thereon are hereby appointed as committee members for the "For" and "Against" Committees, to prepare arguments advocating voters' approval or rejection of Proposition No. 1, concerning restoration of the City's emergency medical services property tax levy, which will appear in the voters' pamphlet for the August 1, 2023, Primary Election.
