- Inclusion does not guarantee funding or completion






Funding: Streets Initiative/REET/Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax \$3,502,222, Surface Transportation Project Grant \$5,622,500

S 25TH STREET TRAFFIC SAFETY ENHANCEMENTS






Project Detail: This project will add bicycle lanes to connect from the Scott Pierson Trail to the Prairie Line Trail, and upgrade curb ramps.
