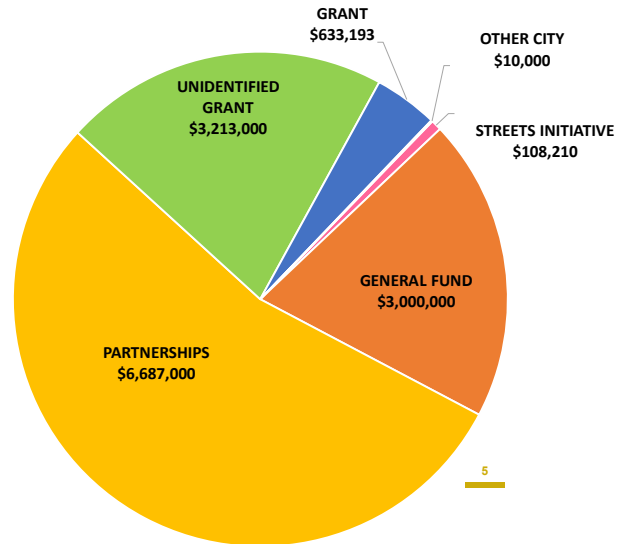

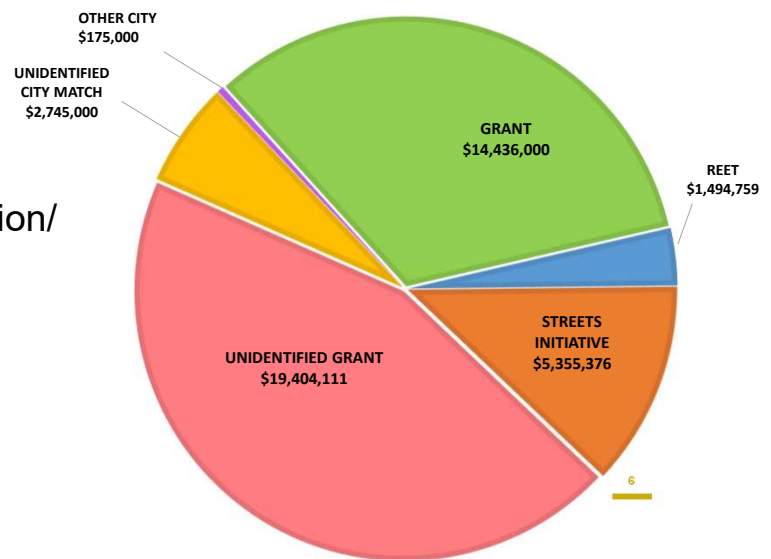

E 34TH ST DECK REPAIR & SEISMIC RETROFIT



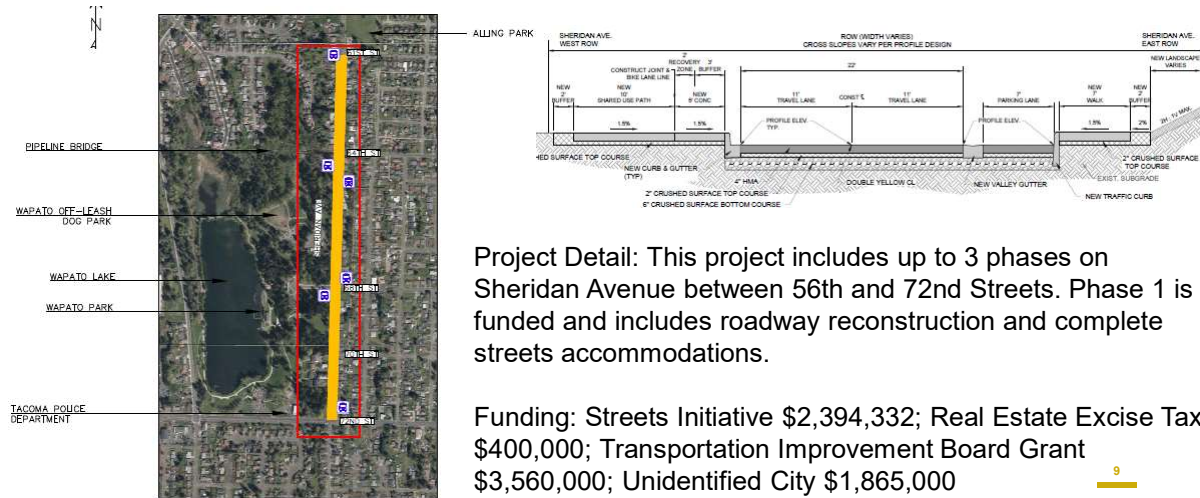
Project Detail: This project includes seismic repairs to the bridge support, bridge deck, streetlighting, and pedestrian separation.

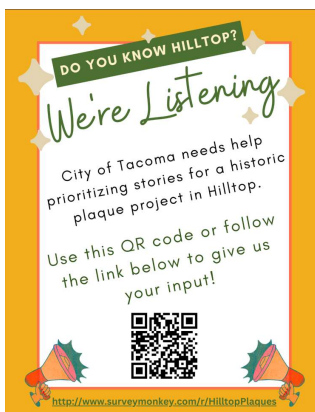

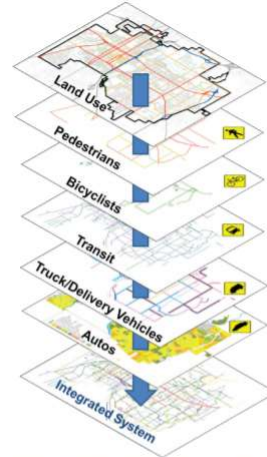
