SUMMARY:

Staff will present on update on the development of the Anti-Displacement Strategy (ADS) an addition to the Affordable Housing Action Strategy. This presentation will be seeking feedback on the remaining information necessary to bring it to full Council for adoption. After receiving CVS feedback, staff plans to complete the draft document in the coming months and return to CVS before presenting at full Council Study Session in anticipation of final adoption.

BACKGROUND:

On November 16, 2021, the City Council passed Resolution 40781 affirming the City's support of the use of data-informed tools to prevent displacement of local residents, such as community prioritization, with a focus on households from "low" and "very low" opportunity areas of the City, as well as Black, Indigenous, and People of Color households.

The development of an anti-displacement strategy not only meets the clear and present need in the community, but also contributes to the effectiveness of other initiatives taking place in the near future. For example, Home in Tacoma will have an affordability/anti-displacement component that will be incorporated into this broader citywide strategy.
