Subject: Fiscal Impact – Local 483 Court Clerks Increase to Bailiff Application of Rate LOA (TA)

Overview

The City of Tacoma, the Municipal Court, and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) Local 483 – Court Clerks bargaining unit have reached a tentative agreement for a Letter of Agreement (LOA).

To maintain a highly effective court operation and to retain current employees, the City and the Municipal Court are requesting to increase the Application of Rate (AOR) for time when employees in the following classification are performing Bailiff related duties: 43210 Court Clerk and 43240 Court Financial Clerk. The request is to increase the Bailiff AOR from the current two percent (2%) above the base classification rate to five percent (5%) above the base classification rate.

Financial Impact

Effective the first pay period (on or about 1 July 2023) after final approval by the Court and the City of Tacoma, the AOR of five percent (5%) shall be paid to employees covered by the 2022-2025 IBEW 483 Court Clerks Collective Bargaining Agreement.
