



ORDINANCE NO. 28968

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to pay and compensation; amending Chapter 1.12 of the
 2 Tacoma Municipal Code (“TMC”) to implement rates of pay and
 3 compensation for employees represented by the Professional and Technical
 4 Employees, Local 17 (“PROTEC17”) and the Brotherhood of Locomotive
 5 Engineers and Trainmen, and declaring the effective dates thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:

6 Section 1. That Section 1.12.355 of the Tacoma Municipal Code (“TMC”)
 7 is hereby amended, effective July 1, 2024, to read as follows:

12 Section 2. That Section 1.12.640 of the TMC is hereby amended,
 13 effective retroactive to November 1, 2023, to read as follows:

1.12.640 Application of additional rates.

21 Section 3. That Section 1.12.640 of the TMC is hereby amended, effective
 22 retroactive to January 1, 2024, to read as follows:

1 4209 A Forensic Services Supervisor (CSC 4209), retroactive to January 1, 2024, upon
2 PCFIT certification during a calendar year, will receive a lump-sum payment of \$750
3 dollars for recognition of that certification. At the start of a new calendar year, a
4 Forensic Services Supervisor (CSC 4209) will receive another certification payment of
5 \$750 if they have remained continuously certified from the previous calendar year's
6 certification payment.

7 Section 4. That Section 1 is effective July 1, 2024, Section 2 is effective
8 retroactive to November 1, 2023, and Section 3 is effective retroactive to
9 January 1, 2024.
