## PIERCE TRANSIT INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF TACOMA TRANSIT SIGNAL PRIORITY

## Amendment 1

WHEREAS, on the 28th day of December, 2010, Pierce Transit and the City of Tacoma (hereinafter called "City") entered into an Interlocal Agreement for the coordination, construction, implementation and ongoing operations of the Transit Signal Priority (TSP) Project; and

WHEREAS, controller software update was required to fully integrate transit priority and pedestrian access at light rail intersections; and

WHEREAS, the change necessitated additional work from the City crews to install and test the upgraded software from the vendor; and

WHEREAS, change orders to the project increased the amount of labor required by the City to install TSP equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement allows for the additional compensation by mutual written agreement; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Agreement is herewith changed as follows:

ARTICLE II, the compensation included in Section A3 as the responsibility of Pierce Transit to the City shall be increased by \$49,576.58 from \$297,908.00 to a total of \$347,484.58.

All other conditions of the Contract remain unchanged.
