

ORDINANCE NO. 28196

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Program; authorizing the adoption of the Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program Amended 2013-2014 and 2015-2020.

WHEREAS RCW 35.77.010 provides that the legislative body of each city and town shall: (1) prepare and adopt a comprehensive transportation program for the ensuing six calendar years and annually thereafter, pursuant to one or more public hearings; (2) prepare and adopt a revised and extended comprehensive transportation program; and (3) file with the Secretary of Transportation of the State of Washington each one-year extension and revision thereof, and

WHEREAS RCW 35.77.010 further provides that each city shall include in its comprehensive transportation program the intended expenditure of revenues for nonmotorized transportation purposes, and

WHEREAS the proposed Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation
Improvement Program Amended 2013-2014 and 2015-2020 ("Program") was presented to the Cross District Association on July 16, 2013, and

WHEREAS each Neighborhood Council was given the opportunity to both view and provide input on the proposed Program during the months of June and July 2013, and

WHEREAS the proposed Program was presented to the Infrastructure,
Planning, and Sustainability Committee on July 24, August 28, and October 9,
2013, and was approved by the committee for consideration by the City Council,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 2. That the Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program Amended 2013-2014 and 2015-2020 is hereby adopted, said document to be substantially in the form of the proposed document on file in the office of the City Clerk.
