

Issues

- Census figures report that 13.4 percent of Tacoma's population is foreign born
- Additionally, 19 percent of our residents speak a primary language other than English in their homes

Issues

- Welcoming Cities and Counties encourages communities in the United States to create more welcoming, immigrant friendly environments that maximize opportunities for economic growth and cultural vitality
- Joining Welcoming Cities and Counties also ties into the City's Equity and Empowerment Initiative
