
#### Port of Tacoma Road Reconstruction Update







## Scope of Project

- Replace existing pavement with new 10" thick concrete roadway from E11th Street to Marshall Avenue
- Add sidewalk and curb ramps for accessible route the project length
- Install permanent traffic signal for WUT and new traffic signal at Lincoln Avenue
- Install ITS infrastructure
- Replace 12" diameter water line from E11th to Lincoln


