SUMMARY:

The Public Works Department recommends a contract be awarded to Sargent Engineers, Inc., in the amount of \$289,218.60, sales tax not applicable, for inspecting, repairing and providing design services for various bridges in Tacoma.

STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

- Strengthen and support a safe city with healthy residents.
- Foster a vibrant and diverse economy with good jobs for all Tacoma residents

This project will inspect Tacoma bridges to ensure the safety of the public. These bridges provide a direct connection to the Port of Tacoma as a transportation corridor for jobs in the Port.

BACKGROUND:

Tacoma bridges are required to be inspected by the Code of Federal Regulation (26 CFR 650). Tacoma follows the Washington State Bridge Inspection Manual to accomplish these inspections. This contract will provide for these inspections including the design of repairs found necessary after these inspections.

ISSUE: Tacoma bridges are inspected every two years with an increase to every year for bridges that have known deficiencies such as the Puyallup River Bridge.

ALTERNATIVES: There are no alternatives to this inspection requirement. If these inspections are not performed, Tacoma would be at risk of losing federal funds for current and future bridge projects.

COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION: The Request for Qualifications was selected from Tacoma's Citywide Architectural and Engineering Roster, CT12-0001F. This is an open and continuous roster. Three consultants were selected and their scoring rank is shown in the table below:
