## Auditor's Exit Conference

Olga Darlington, of the Moss Adams Accounting Firm, outlined her firm's responsibilities under the U. S. auditing standards. The audit began on January 27, 2016. Ms. Darlington reported that all TPU operating divisions received unmodified audit opinions, no material weaknesses, fraudulent acts, or significant deficiencies were found.

## T-Town Report Out

Jim Sant, Deputy Director for Administration, stated that the T-Town Expo was held on May 7 at the Tacoma Dome. The purpose of the event was to raise awareness and showcase city services, educate and exchange ideas with citizens, and receive feedback from citizens. All operating divisions hosted stations at the event such as: water service main connection demonstration, water quality sampling, power bucket truck, conservation and energy usage, Click! games, and Rail hy-rail vehicles. Mr. Sant recognized staff who helped with the event and gave special recognition to Randy Stearnes for overall event coordination. Positive survey results on the event were shared. The City plans another T-Town event in two years.

#### <u>Miscellaneous</u>

Director Gaines gave a brief report on TPU's participation in the region-wide Cascadia Rising earthquake drill that simulates the impacts and aftermath of a 9.0 Cascadia subduction zone earthquake and tsunami. The military, various government agencies, and utility companies participated. TPU participation is part of larger effort began last year to enhance emergency planning. Linda McCrea, Water Superintendent, is the executive team sponsor for emergency planning. Superintendent McCrea outlined the various steps of the drill, which also includes simulations, opening of the Emergency Operations Center, FEMA coordination, and an exercise debrief.
