**Dear Mayor and Council Members:** 

### **ACTION REQUESTED**

1. Starting July through the month of September, the City Council evening meetings will be moved to the Tacoma Public Utility Auditorium, located at 3628 South 35th Street, during the City Council Chamber upgrades and improvement project.

### **ITEMS OF INTEREST**

- 2. As you travel home from Tuesday's City Council meeting, you will notice many street closures throughout the City. These block parties or street closures are neighbors getting together celebrating "National Night Out." Tacoma citizens will join millions of people across the country on Tuesday for this annual event. Please see the attached list of neighborhoods participating.
- 3. I am pleased to report, that the City of Tacoma will be have a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony to commemorate the completion of the Tacoma Avenue South Bridge Rehabilitation Project on Thursday, August 4<sup>th</sup>, from 2:00 to 3:00 p.m. The ceremony will be held on the bridge located on Tacoma Avenue South between Center and South Delin streets.

After a nearly 16 month closure, the City reopened the bridge this past June. The closure was necessary to reconstruct the bridge deck, guardrails, replace the girders, and paint the steel members of the over 80-year-old bridge. Traffic lanes have also been reconfigured to three vehicular lanes, with two bicycle lanes and wider sidewalks added.

#### STUDY SESSION/WORK SESSION

4. The City Council Study Session of Tuesday, August 2, 2016, will be held in Room 16 of the Tacoma Municipal Building North, at Noon. Discussion items will include: (1) Second Quarter Financial Report; (2) Other Items of Interest; (3) Committee Reports; (4) Agenda Review and City Manager's Weekly Report; and, (5) Executive Session – Potential Litigation.

At Tuesday's Study Session, Office of Management and Budget staff will provide Council with a 2016 Second Quarter Financial Report, based on actual revenues and expenditures.
