### Overview

Washington Alliance for Humane Legislation proposed a revision to the Tacoma Municipal Code, Title 17, Animal Control to include adequate care standards for animals

City Ordinance #28271 Passed on December 16, 2014



# Background

The ordinance was designed to ensure that animals have basic and adequate care

Animal Control Officers focus on education with the pet owners as the first step in achieving compliance with the law

Enforcement is the next step



## 2015 Statistics

- Total calls for service 8675
- Calls for service regarding neglect 423
- Infractions issued for neglect/adequate care violations 3



### **Education**

 Officers have determined that most citizens do not intend to violate the ordinance and have been responsive to education

 Education has been successful in stopping animal neglect and keeping pets with their owners



### **Next Steps**

 Animal Control Officers and staff will continue their education and enforcement efforts with pet owners
