Briefing Items

1. <u>16-0756</u> Community Needs Assessment

Deputy Mayor Mello and Council Member McCarthy arrived here, at 12:05 p.m.

At approximately 12:06 p.m., Nadia Chandler Hardy, Neighborhood and Community Services Director, provided an overview of the recently completed Community Needs Assessment, including background and purpose, and introduced Dawn Couch, BERK Consulting. Ms. Couch discussed guiding documents, components, a web-based data tool, and provided a summary of the assessment findings. She concluded by discussing the unmet needs of the community. Ms. Chandler Hardy concluded the presentation by discussing changes going forward, and next steps.

Discussion ensued throughout regarding the definition of poverty, adolescent drug use, bullying, housing cost burden, affordable housing shortage, support for utilizing a systems approach to human services and having an open dialog about the assessment findings.
