14	bargaining agreement and the compensation plan: Chief of Party, PLS (CSC	
15	2401), Assistant Chief Surveyor, PLS (CSC 2403), and Senior Vehicle & Equipment	
16 17	Shop Supervisor (CSC 5345), and	
18	WHEREAS employees currently assigned to the classifications of Chief of	
19	Party, PLS (CSC 2401) and Assistant Chief Surveyor, PLS (CSC 2403) will move	
20	into the base classifications of Chief of Party (CSC 2003) and Assistant Chief	
21	Surveyor (CSC 2005), and will maintain their current job seniority and receive	
22 23	6 percent in certification pay, as previously included in the classifications set for	
24	deletion, as long as they maintain a valid PLS certification, and	
25	WHEREAS the classification of Senior Vehicle & Equipment Shop	
26	Supervisor (CSC 5345) is vacant and no longer in use, and
