#### **SUMMARY:**

The Public Assembly Facilities (PAF) Department recommends a contract be awarded to Republic Parking Northwest, Inc., Tacoma, WA, in the amount of \$671,574.00, plus applicable taxes, for professional parking services for Tacoma Dome parking facilities, for an initial contract term of four years plus one additional two-year renewal option, for a projected contract amount of \$1,007,360.00, plus applicable taxes.

## STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

- Plan for and improve public infrastructure and services that meet the transportation needs of all Tacoma residents and visitors.
- Foster neighborhood, community and economic development vitality and sustainability.

Tacoma Dome parking operations are integral to the enterprise's customer service delivery and financial success. As a key source of revenue, operations must be fiscally sound, sustainable and customer centric.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

In order to attain optimal revenue and service goals, PAF requires an industry specific and expert contractor with proven experience enhancing the revenue potential of parking operations. The contractor will provide ongoing professional parking services including daily operations, event operations and enhanced customer service support for the users and clients of the Tacoma Dome parking system.

ISSUE: Obtain an experienced contractor for parking management and operations of the Tacoma Dome facilities to increase overall use and revenues. This contract requires experience and expertise in off-street daily and monthly parking operations, and event based parking operations.

ALTERNATIVES: PAF requires professional parking services to operate the Tacoma Dome parking lots. PAF currently does not have the workforce or expertise to perform this function. The current contract with Staff Pro Security Inc expires November 1, 2016.

COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION: Request for Proposals Specification No. PF16-0327F for Operation Services for Tacoma Dome's Parking Facilities was opened August 9, 2016. Five companies were invited to bid in addition to normal advertising of the project. Two submittals were received. Republic Parking Northwest, Inc. achieved the highest total score.
