The following provides a financial analysis for negotiated wage increases for represented classifications effective in 2017.

Financial Impact: Summary

Effective January 1, 2017, wage rates for the bargaining units herein will increase by amounts ranging from 2.0% to 2.68%. The combined fiscal impact of each of these bargaining units is immediately below. The fiscal impact for each individual unit is detailed below this summary.

Financial Impact


Effective January 1, 2017 wage rates for Teamsters Local 313 classifications have been negotiated to increase by 2%.

Financial Impact of Teamsters 117 Public Assembly Facilities (PAF) Wage Increase

Overview

The following provides a financial analysis for wage increases for Teamsters 117 Public Assembly Facilities effective either 1/1/2017 or immediately following ratification of the agreement, whichever is later. For this analysis the effective date is assumed to be 1/1/2017.

Financial Impact

Effective 1/1/2017, the classifications of PAF Custodian, PAF Maintenance Chief, PAF Maintenance Chief Assistant, PAF Maintenance Worker I, and PAF Maintenance Worker II shall receive a 1% increase. Effective 1/1/2018 these classifications shall receive an additional 1% increase.

Effective 1/1/2017, the classifications of PAF Electrician and PAF HVAC Mechanic shall receive a 2% salary increase. Effective 1/1/2018 these classifications shall receive an additional 2% increase.

Fiscal Impact of Local 26 IUPA, Tacoma Police Management Association 2015-2017 Contract

Overview

The following provides a financial analysis of increases for Local 26 IUPA, Tacoma Police Management Association 2015-2017 contract effective upon City Council approval.

The contract includes one-time and ongoing costs for multiple areas and they are explained and shown below in aggregate:

Financial Impact: Ongoing Costs

<u>Wages:</u> Effective January 1, 2015 all wages shall increase by 2.2%. Effective January 1, 2016 all wages shall increase by 1.1%. Effective January 1, 2017 all wages shall increase by 2.0%.

Mentoring Pay: Effective January 1, 2017 highly experienced employees, with at least 25 years of service as a commissioned Tacoma police officer, shall receive a 2.0% application of rate.

<u>VEBA</u>: Effective January 1, 2017 the contribution to the individual VEBA will increase from \$50 per month to \$100 per month for each LEOFF II member of the bargaining unit.

Merit Allowance: Effective January 1, 2017 the Merit Allowance shall be increased from \$3,500 per year to \$3,750 per year.
