### **Briefing Items**

2. <u>17-0036</u> Curran Road Water Acquisition [Ryan Flynn, Senior Principal Planner, TPU]

At approximately 4:36 p.m., Ryan Flynn, Tacoma Water, provided an overview of the Curran Road water acquisition, including the service area expansion policy, a Curran Road system description, benefits of acquisition, system improvement strategy, surcharge proposal, bill comparison, and the consolidation sequence. Preston Devers, President, Curran Road Mutual Water Association Board of Directors, provided information relative to Pierce County zoning, and next steps.

Discussion ensued throughout regarding service area expansions and consideration of the Vision 2040 plan, and the City of Fircrest water system.

3. <u>17-0037</u> Planning Services Community Engagement Plan [Stephen Atkinson, Senior Planner, PDS]

At approximately 4:54 p.m., Stephen Atkinson, Planning and Development Services, provided an overview of the 2017-2018 Work Program, including the continuation of the Tacoma Mall Subarea Plan, Residential Infill Pilot Program, Historic Demolition Review, Hilltop Links to Opportunity, and Unified Development Code; future land use and rezones; commercial zoning and development standards; open space/steep slope standards, institutional campus zoning review, and Joint Base Lewis McChord – Accident Potential Zone. He then discussed the Long-Range Planning Public Engagement Plan, including early notification, equity in engagement, diverse methods, planning and development forum, schedule, and committee feedback.

Discussion ensued throughout regarding Pierce Transit, the addition of an educational component to the engagement plan, methods, promotion and participation in meetings, and meeting design.
