

## **RESOLUTION NO. 39694**

A RESOLUTION setting April 18, 2017, as the date for a public hearing on the recommendations of the Community and Economic Development Department for the 2017-2018 Annual Action Plan for Housing and Community Development.

WHEREAS the Annual Action Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") will ensure the City will receive federal funds to manage its housing, community and economic development, neighborhood improvement, homeless assistance and social service programs, and

WHEREAS the Annual Action Plan outlined the City's uses of Community

Development Block Grant ("CDBG"), HOME Investment Partnership ("HOME"),

and Emergency Solutions Grant ("ESG") funds, and

WHEREAS, based on guidance by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"), the City anticipates that it will be entitled to apply to HUD for entitlement grant allocations as follows: (1) CDBG, in the amount of \$2,250,000; (2) HOME, in the amount of \$998,000; and (3) ESG, in the amount of \$201,000, and

WHEREAS, because the City of Lakewood ("Lakewood") does not qualify to apply for HOME funds independently, the City and Lakewood formed a consortium in 1999 for the HOME Program, and

WHEREAS, as a result of the consortium, a portion of the HOME funds will be allocated to Lakewood, and

WHEREAS, during January and February 2017, the Tacoma Community
Redevelopment Authority and Human Services Commission reviewed

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applications for funding, heard presentations by agencies applying for funding, considered the historic performance of those agencies and the needs of the community, and prepared funding recommendations based thereon, and

WHEREAS funding recommendations were finalized at the March 9, 2017, regular meeting of the Community Vitality and Safety Committee, and were recommended for consideration by the City Council at its meeting of May 2, 2017, and

WHEREAS, before submission of the Annual Action Plan to HUD, the City must fulfill certain citizen participation requirements, including holding a public hearing on the proposed plan, and

WHEREAS the draft Annual Action Plan will be available for public review for a period of 30 days, beginning on April 1, 2017, and ending on April 30, 2017; Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That Tuesday, April 18, 2017, at approximately 5:15 p.m., is hereby fixed as the time, and the City Council Chambers on the First Floor of the Tacoma Municipal Building, 747 Market Street, Tacoma, Washington, as the place when and where a public hearing shall be held on the recommendations of the Community and Economic Development Department for the City's proposed 2017-2018 Annual Action Plan for Housing and Community Development.
