

Commercial office incentives
 (HB1495): Local tax incentive for
 commercial office space. House
 removed property tax. Senate restored
 property tax, added more cities. Bill in
 W&M. If passed: concurrence or
 conference.

- Document recording fees (HB1570, SB5254):
  - HB: Permanent \$40 surcharge,
     option for counties to increase up to \$90. In House Rules.
  - SB: Extend surcharge 8 years, adds more docs, no increase, multiple GMA amendments. On Senate floor calendar.

- Ban the box (HB1298/SB5312): Both passed. SB: 25-24, but bipartisan. HB: 68-30. SB has more exemptions.
- PFD tax credit (HB1201): Allows GTCC to use state-shared sales tax credit (.33) that repays bonds issued for construction to also be used for expansion, rehabilitation, and improvement. Extends credit from 25 to 40 years. Passed House 89-9. In Rules.

- PRA amendments (HB1594 & HB1595):
  - 1594 requires training of records officers; adds \$1 DRF on all documents & establishes grants for local govt. & a study of a statewide open records portal. Requires city to report to JLARC annually on records requests.
  - 1595 allows fees for electronic records & complex requests, bans "bot" requests.
