Briefing Items

2. <u>17-0530</u> Historic Demolition Review/Code Updates [Reuben McKnight, Historic Preservation Officer, Planning and Development Services]

> At approximately 4:37 p.m., Reuben McKnight, Planning and Development Services, provided an overview of the presentation and reviewed background information, key questions, policy foundation, current status quo, potential approaches, data sources for historic inventories, policy framework proposal,

and potential code areas.

Discussion ensued throughout the presentation regarding the meaning of the review, duration of the pilot, area coverage, State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) threshold exemptions, developers' interest, and demolition application process.

Chair Mello proposed the City Manager's Office hold a SEPA Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) 101 class during a Study Session or Committee meeting.

Assistant City Manager Mark Lauzier noted that he will schedule the class to be held at a Study Session.

3. <u>17-0531</u> Tacoma-Pierce County Solid Waste Management/Long Term Solid Waste Contract Extension [Mike Slevin, Director, Environmental Services; Gary Kato, Solid Waste Management Division Manager, Environmental Services]

At approximately 5:11 p.m., Gary Kato, Environmental Services (ES), made opening remarks and introduced Lewis Griffith, ES, and John Rogers and Jody Snyder, Waste Connections. He then provided an overview of the Pierce County Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP), including the background, the need for updating SWMP, plan framework, vision and goals, formal review and approval process, and planning process. Mr. Griffith then provided information on disposal contract options, existing contract with Land Recover, Inc. (LRI), average disposal rate, inflation impacts, regional rail cost, projected disposal costs, other considerations with rail, and staff recommendations.

Discussion ensued throughout the presentation regarding the landfill capacity, effect on comprehensive plan, today's rate on disposal, LRI costs, rail haul facility options, contract extension timeline, and timeline for City Council approval.
