## ITEM/ISSUE PROPOSED FOR COUNCIL CONSIDERATION:

I ask for your support for the inclusion of the following item on the agenda at the earliest available meeting of the Study Session:

I respectfully ask for City Council concurrence to allocate \$25,000 from the Council Contingency Fund to hire a third party consultant to develop a downtown retail enhancement strategy.

#### **BRIEF BACKGROUND:**

On May 9, 2017 the Economic Development Committee was briefed on retail strategies for downtown revitalization and neighborhood revitalization. During this presentation Downtown Works, a retail consulting company presented an overview of how successful shopping districts are planned and implemented though development of merchandise mix plans, prospecting strategies, project pro formas, leasing plans, branding, and training local recruiters. The committee heard the critical importance of a healthy downtown commercial district, how it contributes significantly to economic development and increases livability.

This company has previously partnered with the University of Washington Tacoma (UWT), helping develop and implement a retail strategy to revitalize Pacific Avenue near the UWT campus, with much success. Through our partnership, the City plans to build off the successes of Pacific Avenue and identify another area to revitalize downtown. This request further addresses the community priorities emphasized in Tacoma2025, to improve neighborhood business districts and strengthen downtown Tacoma as a business core and residential option.

Should council approve this request, the work and full retail enhancement strategy is anticipated to be completed by December 2017 and cost \$50,000. Council Contingency would fund \$25,000 of the contract and the Community and Economic Development Department would fund the remaining \$25,000.

### **FUNDING REQUESTED:**

I request the City Council allocate \$25,000 from the Council Contingency Fund to hire a third party consultant to develop retail strategies for downtown revitalization.
