

## **RESOLUTION NO. 39784**

A RESOLUTION relating to the Tacoma Fire Department; authorizing the acceptance of a Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response ("SAFER") grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, in the amount of \$2,163,101, for deposit into the Fire Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund, to hire, train, and employ 12 additional firefighters for a three-year period.

WHEREAS the Tacoma Fire Department submitted a grant application to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security for a Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response ("SAFER") grant to hire, train, and employ 12 additional firefighters for a three-year period, and

WHEREAS the application was approved for a grant award commencing

January 24, 2018, but an earlier start date can be requested from the Federal

Emergency Management Agency, and

WHEREAS, if accepted by the City, the grant will reimburse the City for approximately 62 percent of the estimated regular wage and benefit costs of the additional positions during the three-year period, and

WHEREAS additional City funding, in the amount of approximately \$1,344,631, will be needed to fully fund these positions in 2018-2020, and such funds will be appropriated in future budget ordinances, and

WHEREAS the grant requires that no layoffs of commissioned TFD personnel occur during the three-year period, and

WHEREAS the positions will be used to staff an additional engine in the Tide Flats, which will reduce response time to incidents in that area and in Northeast Tacoma; Now, Therefore,



## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to accept a Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response ("SAFER") grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, in the amount of \$2,163,101, for deposit into the Fire Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund, to hire, train, and employ 12 additional firefighters for a three-year period, said document to be substantially in the form of the proposed grant application on file in the office of the City Clerk.
