Street Vacation 124.1384 – Puyallup Tribe of Indians

#### **SUMMARY:**

A resolution setting Thursday, November 16, 2017, at 9:00 a.m., as the date and time for a hearing before the Hearing Examiner on the Puyallup Tribe of Indian's request to vacate all that portion of the remnant alley segment between East 29<sup>th</sup> Street and East 30<sup>th</sup> Street lying east of East R Street and west of the East 30<sup>th</sup> Street connector road, to be constructed by the Puyallup Tribe of Indians, as approved under City of Tacoma Work Order Number 16-0040, all abutting and adjacent Tribal property, in preparation of a new multi-level garage structure, casino, hotel and restaurant.

## STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

- Foster a vibrant and diverse economy with good jobs for all Tacoma residents.
- Cultivate a vibrant cultural sector that fosters a creative, cohesive community.

Vacation of this alley will assist in furthering the development of the Tribal community by constructing a garage structure serving the proposed new location of the expanded Emerald Queen Casino.

## **BACKGROUND:**

A petition has been filed by the Puyallup Tribe of Indians for the vacation of the remnant alley segment, to be bisected upon completion of the East 30<sup>th</sup> Street connector road to the proposed roundabout to be constructed in East 29<sup>th</sup> Street, all in furtherance of constructing a multi-level parking structure, casino, hotel and restaurant.

#### **ISSUE:**

Pursuant to RCW 35.79 and TMC 9.22 the Public Works Department is requesting the City Council set a date to consider this request for a street vacation to be heard by the Hearing Examiner and report the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendation to the City Council for their consideration.

#### **ALTERNATIVES:**

City Council could decide not to approve this request to set a date for public hearing, which will halt the application for street vacation.

### RECOMMENDATION:

The Public Works Department recommends City Council approve this request to set the Hearing Examiner's public hearing date for Thursday, November 16, 2017, at 9:00 a.m.

# FISCAL IMPACT:

This action only sets the date of the hearing before the Hearing Examiner. The City will receive market value compensation for the vacated right-of-way. The proceeds will be deposited in accordance with TMC 9.22.
