## **RESOLUTION NO. 39870**

1	BY REQUEST OF COUNCIL MEMBER CAMPBELL
2	A RESOLUTION authorizing the use of City Council Contingency Funds, in an
3	amount of up to \$10,000, for expenses related to the Eastside Food Innovation District Project through the Livable City Year agreement with the University of Washington Tacoma.
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6	WHEREAS poor food health contributes to poor school performance and to
7	health issues such as diabetes, heart disease, stroke, and some cancers, and
8	WHEREAS a root cause of poor food health is poverty, as nutritional foods
9	can cost more than five times as much as "junk" and processed foods, and
10	WHEREAS, on November 24, 2015, the City Council adopted Resolution
11	No. 39321, authorizing a contribution of \$10,000 from the City Council Contingency
12	Fund to the Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department's ("TPCHD") Innovation
13	Initiative, for the purpose of improving the "food health" of low-income residents in
14 15	East Tacoma, and to create sustainable jobs and small businesses based on
16	healthy food, and
17	WHEREAS the negotiated agreement with TPCHD stated that it must secure
18	an additional \$70,000 for the planning phase of the initiative prior to receiving any
19 20	funds from the City, and
20	WHEREAS the TPCHD was unable to raise the additional \$70,000 by
22	March 31, 2017, and the agreement expired because the funding contingency was
23	not met, and
24	WHEREAS Council Contingency Funds remain obligated for this purpose,
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26	but have not been spent, and
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WHEREAS, on August 15, 2017, the City Council approved Resolution 1 No. 39781, authorizing an agreement in the amount of \$350,000 with the University 2 of Washington Tacoma ("UWT") for the Livable City Year Program, for public health, 3 urban design, economic development, and community services projects throughout 4 the City, and 5 WHEREAS one of the designated projects is the Eastside Food Innovation 6 7 District, which has the same purpose as the original TPCHD initiative, to address 8 issues around access to healthy food in the Eastside of Tacoma, as well as jobs 9 and business opportunities that will increase the resources available to Eastside 10 residents, and 11 WHEREAS staff is recommending the redirection of \$10,000 of City Council 12 13 Contingency Funds from the TPCHD initiative to the UWT Livable City Year 14 Program project, and 15 WHEREAS RCW 35.33.145 and 35.34.250 authorize a withdrawal from the 16 Contingency Fund for any municipal expense, the necessity or extent of which 17 18 could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time of adopting the 19 budget, and 20 WHEREAS the City Council's request to use funds from the Contingency 21 Fund for expenses related to the Eastside Food Innovation District Project is 22 necessary and could not have reasonably been foreseen or evaluated at the time 23 24 the City Council adopted the budget, and 25 26



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	WHEREAS Ordinance No. 22569 requires an affirmative vote of not less	
1	than six members of the City Council in order to withdraw moneys from this fund;	
2	Now, Therefore,	
3	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:	
4 5	That one-time funding in the amount of \$10,000, budgeted from the City	
6	Council Contingency Fund, is hereby approved for expenses related to the Eastside	
7	Food Innovation District Project through the Livable City Year agreement with the	
8	University of Washington Tacoma.
