2018 Fiscal Impact of Represented and Non-Represented Wage Increases

Overview

The following provides a financial analysis for negotiated wage increases for represented and non-represented classifications effective in 2018.

Financial Impact: Professional & Technical Employees, Local 17

Effective January 1, 2018, wage rates for Local 17, Professional & Technical Employees, will increase by 2.0%.

Financial Impact: Teamsters Local Union No. 117, General Unit

Effective January 1, 2018, wage rates for Local 117, Teamsters, General Unit, will increase by 2.5%.

Financial Impact: Non-Represented Increases

Effective January 1, 2018 wage rates for non-represented classifications will receive market adjustments according to the following criteria:

1. Effective January 1, 2018, eligible non-represented and non-represented executive classifications will receive the balance of the determined 2017 market-based wage adjustment, up to a cap of 6 percent as follows:

2. Additionally, as reflected in the 2017/2018 biennial budget ordinance, all non-represented and non-represented executive classifications wages will increase by 3 percent, effective January 1, 2018.

The estimated cost of all non-represented wage increases for 2018 is listed in the table below.
