ORDINANCE NO. 28474

AN ORDINANCE relating to Capital Facilities Program and Capital Budget; 1 amending the 2017-2022 Capital Facilities Element of the Comprehensive 2 Plan to include a new project, NCS Readiness Site, to the Program's Community Development section; and amending the City of Tacoma 3 2017-2018 Capital Budget. 4 WHEREAS the purpose of the Capital Facilities Program is to provide 5 Tacoma with a comprehensive capital facilities overview and to guide policy 6 7 decisions for capital improvements and services, and capital budget decisions, and 8 WHEREAS, periodically, the Capital Facilities Program is updated with new 9 information on capital projects for the next six-year cycle, and 10 WHEREAS the City Council desires to amend the 2017-2022 Capital 11 Facilities Element of the Comprehensive Plan concurrently with the amendment 12 and adoption of the 2017-2018 Capital Budget, and 13 14 WHEREAS, on May 9, 2017, the City Council adopted Ordinance 15 No. 28430, which declared a state of emergency relating to the conditions of 16 homeless encampments and authorizing such actions as reasonable and 17 necessary, in light of such emergency, to mitigate the conditions giving rise to such 18 19 public emergency, and 20 WHEREAS the City Council finds it to be in the best interests of the City to 21 add a new project, NCS Readiness Site, to the Capital Facilities Element of the 22 Comprehensive Plan, relating to the issue of homeless encampments in the City of 23 Tacoma, and 24 25 WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.34, the City must pass an ordinance that 26 appropriates estimated expenditures and revenues/use of available funds, and -1-
