City bills of interest



- Commercial office incentives (HB 2813 / SB 6418): Both bills have died. Similar SB 6361 bill remains alive.
- Leasehold excise tax (HB 1114 / SB 6320): Tacoma Dome only venue required to collect. In Finance and Ways & Means. Hearing this week in Senate.
- Body worn cameras (SB 6408): Passed Senate 47-0. Hearing in House committee this week.

City bills of interest



- Sound Transit MVET (HB 2201 / SB 5955): New schedule. Rebates. House passed 60-37. NTIB issue.
- Abandoned homes (HB 2057): Increases cost recovery. New process for foreclosed homes. House passed 96-2. Senate committee hearing last week.
- Flexible revenue (HB 2006): Mental health & levy lid. Passed House 92-6. Senate committee hearing this week.

City bills of interest



- Small cells (HB 2592 / SB 5935): Two very different approaches. 5935 passed Senate 45-3. Hearing this week.
- Voting Rights Act (SB 6002): Changes local elections. Passed Senate 29-19. Passed House committee. In Rules.
- Document recording fee (HB 1570): \$50 fee increase. In Rules. Passed House 51-47. Senate committee hearing this week. City option if county fails to act.

Budgets



- **SUPPLEMENTAL OPERATING BUDGET:**
- Senate: \$403 million reduction in State property tax for 2019, maybe 2018
 - .31 reduction per \$1000 & Requires a 60 percent vote
- \$1.2 net new funds for K-12 salaries. Fully funds McCleary, including penalties.
- \$160 million additional funding for mental health/development disabilities.
- House: Released this hour. Expected to include new Capital Gains Tax revenue to reduce property taxes and no use of budget stabilization account.
- **SUPPLEMENTAL CAPITAL BUDGET:**
- Language allowing State to negotiate Rhodes Building complex sale to the City.
- THA Arlington Drive facility: \$750,000
- Asia Pacific Cultural Center: \$250,000
