City bills of interest



Some disappointments

- Commercial office incentives (HB 2813 / SB 6418): Our bills
 & similar bill from Spokane died. Plan to reach out to
 Spokane to look at options for 2019.
- Tacoma Dome leasehold excise tax (HB 1114 / SB 6320):
 Circumstances changed during session. New House committee chair should improve 2019 chances.

City bills of interest



- Sound Transit MVET (HB 2201 / SB 5955) Change MVET schedule & address revenue impacts.
- <u>Flexible revenue</u> (HB 2006 / HB 1797): Mental health, levy lid & REET flexibility and use for affordable housing.



City bills of interest



Key successes

- Small cells (HB 2592 / SB 5935): No bill passed.
- Voting Rights Act (SB 6002): All cities over 1000 authorized to adopt district elections & allows local cause of action.
- <u>Document recording fee</u> (HB 1570): Fee raised to \$62 & made permanent.



City bills of interest



- Marijuana revenue increase (SB 6032): Increases sharing of revenue from \$6 to \$15 million per year starting this week.
- Abandoned homes (HB 2057): Increases cost recovery, creates a new process for abandoned homes that are midforeclosure.
