

BACKGROUND Capital Projects (included in TIP) Arterial roadways, bridges, bike facilities, sidewalks, trails, curb ramps Maintenance Projects (not included in TIP) Potholes, chip seal, residential overlays, Transportation Benefit District projects Most Streets Initiatives Draft Six-Year Improvement Program available at Cityoftacoma.org/TIP

• Funding: \$1,499,000 Various Funds

• Scope: Pedestrian Safety/Crossing Improvements

• Funding: \$500,000 General Fund

• Scope: Missing link sidewalk installation, pedestrian mobility and accessibility improvements

• Funding: \$346,000 TIB Grant, \$156,190 Streets Initiative




• Scope: Expansion Joint Replacement and Concrete Overlay
